

Lakeland Students Promote 'Heart Walk' After Sudden Death of 16-Year-Old Volleyball Standout

Julia Black, a junior at Harrison School of the Arts, suffered a sudden cardiac arrest caused by a pericardial infection.

High school junior Julia Black, 16, played in a varsity volleyball game on Wednesday and attended all of her classes on Friday. Then suddenly, inexplicably, she was gone.

Polk County Fire Rescue was dispatched to the teen's home at 8:23 p.m. on Friday for a medical assistance call. However, paramedics were unable to revive her. In Black's <u>obituary</u>, her family said she suffered a sudden cardiac arrest caused by a pericardial infection.

"We are reeling," Harrison School for the Arts counselor Amy Benningfield said of students and staff. "Julia was an amazing student in every way. She was exceptional academically, musically and in athletics, leadership and friendship. She was well-liked by students and teachers and will be greatly missed at Harrison."

Black was the lead oboist in the Harrison orchestra and a key member of Lakeland High School's varsity volleyball team. The 5-foot-11 middle blocker earned "player of the game" recognition three times this season. She was also vice president of Harrison's Arts Council and vice president of the National English Honor Society.
